
The Flathead Indian Reservation encompasses over 1.25 million acres of land in western Montana, from the valley floor at 2,800 ft to nearly 10,000 ft at the peak of the Mission Mountain Tribal Wilderness Area.

While enjoying the scenery of the reservation, the CSKT Natural Resource Department would like to remind you that all non-tribal members require a Tribal-State Conservation license for recreating on tribally owned lands and waters. Separate bird hunting and fishing licenses are required for those activities, available with the conservation licenses.

Some of the best spots for viewing waterfowl and shorebirds are the Ninepipes National Wildlife Refuge, Pablo National Wildlife Refuge, and Kicking Horse Reservoir. Opportunities for birding can also be found at areas along the

Flathead Lake, Flathead River, and the CSKT Bison Range. Please be sure to treat all wildlife with respect and caution. Do not approach them too closely, no matter how tame they may appear. Viewers should also follow all regulations in the area that might be in effect. Leave the area as clean as when you arrived, your cooperation will help preserve the area for others to enjoy!
